Deputy Sheriff Marc Petrucelli began his law enforcement career in July of 2000. He is currently certified by the State of Florida as a law enforcement officer, field training officer and law enforcement instructor. Marc has received advanced training in the areas of human trafficking.

As a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Task Force Agent with the Tampa Crimes Against Children Task Force, Marc was cross sworn and credentialed with the FBI allowing him federal authority and federal arrest powers nationwide for crimes related to juvenile sex trafficking.

The Faroe Islands are great! I am still learning more Faroese day by day, it is a very hard language. Every Thursday (today) I have a Faroese lesson from 6-7 pm and there are two other exchange students that go too, not through Rotary but through AFS. One is from Germany and the other is from Belgium.

The holidays were great and I didn't get too homesick, luckily. My host family and I went to a town close to the airport which was very beautiful and we stayed with some family there. We ate a lot too! On Christmas Eve we had Duck and for dessert we had Rice cake and then we opened presents. We didn't finish until about 1am! The next day we had an early dinner, dried lamb. It's a special Faroese dish where they hang the lamb for several months before its ready to be eaten. I personally think all special Faroese food smells the same. They even have dried fish where they hang the fish for several months or bury it for several months.

I spent New Year's in Klaksvik with my host family and then went out with my friends for the night. Overall it was a great holiday and I hope these next months don't go by too fast!
