Eradicating polio is a top Rotary priority which requires the immunization of every child under 5 in the world. As a result of the efforts of Rotary and its global partners, more than one billion children have been immunized against polio since 1985.

Rotary members have given approximately \$500 million to the campaign. The goal is certification of a polio-free world. Through The Rotary Foundation's PolioPlus program, more than one million Rotary volunteers from around the globe have contributed to the success of polio eradication efforts. Rotary is the key private sector partner in this international health effort. Public-sector partners include the World Health Organization

(WHO), UNICEF and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). At last year's Rotary International Conference, we learned that we are very near eradicating polio in the world. That goal should be reached in the near future.
