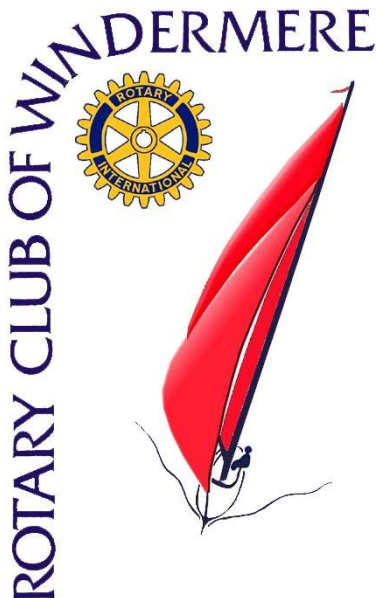

# Club Members: Here are the Luau Needs!

**Physical needs:** (maybe you can think of someone or some organization that can donate)

1. Water bottles for the tables and the bar and for the setup crew throughout the day.
2. Palm fronds to decorate with. Last year Stephen Withers had a bunch he had just cut. Perhaps someone has a lawn service that might be able to procure??
3. We need food throughout the day for the kids and adults setting up. Doughnuts in the morning, pizza and/or subs for lunch.
4. Small but unique centerpiece for the tables. Needs to be able to support the sign with the table number and name.
5. We would really like to get rum or vodka donated so that we can make a specialty drink. The plan right now is just to have one or two specialty drinks and not a full bar. Someone take this bull by the horns and see if we can get a distributor as a sponsor.
6. Beer. It would be great if we could get Hawaiian themed beers (Kona, ??) donated. Think World of Beers, other places like that. Last year these sold out quickly and nobody wanted Bud or Bud Lite.
7. Dessert. We need something small and easy for dessert. One thought was to have a cookie baking party and we Rotarians do the baking a few days before the event. Better would be to get something donated. Anyone know a baker?

## **Jobs that need doin':**

1. Two greeters that meet arriving customers and help them find their seats.
2. One or two people to handle walk-ups and ticket sales at the event.
3. Expeditors. We expect all Rotarians to be involved somehow. During the event we need people roaming around doing whatever needs to be done to make things run smoothly. Doors held open for the waiters, spills cleaned up, questions answered, bathrooms checked occasionally and restocked, ice replenished at the bar.
4. Set up throughout the day. We have a few volunteers, but the more the merrier. Tables set up, tables decorated, room decorated, auction site set up and decorated, bar tent set up, etc.
5. Someone, or many, to wash all the serving implements the day after the event. This is a pretty big job. It all goes into our storage facility, but needs to be cleaned.
6. Someone to take care of the entertainers. We have an entertainer to help with greeting and the luau dancers during and after dinner. We need to offer them water and help them get set up. Whatever they need.

Dear Home at Last Friends, Supporters & Rotarians:

Windermere Charities Central Florida (WCCF) Foundation is having a fund raising golf tournament **on October 8, 2015** at the Marriott Orlando World Center Resort's Hawk's Landing Golf Course to help the Home at Last Project build a house for disabled Marine Staff Sergeant Brandon Wittwer and his family; wife Kassandra and children Kaydence, Karter and Kylee.

SSgt. Wittwer enlisted in the Marine Corps in 2002. During his deployment to Iraq in 2006 as a Scout Sniper Team Leader, his unit was ambushed. Despite severe head, neck, and back pain as a result of an RPG explosion, SSgt. Wittwer continued to assist injured Marines in his unit. Following rehab and time with his family, SSgt. Wittwer redeployed in 2013. During a training exercise while deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, SSgt. Wittwer suffered further spinal injuries. As a result of these injuries, he was honorably discharged from the Marine Corps in November 2014 with a 100% disability rating. Over time his mobility is expected to be limited to the use of a wheelchair.

Many past and present recipients are scheduled to attend the event. If you are unable to play but still want to "do something to say thanks to the military", please consider becoming a sponsor, donating an auction item, or making a donation.

*Come and enjoy a great day of golf, and help provide support for our heroes. The event will include a 4 - person scramble, breakfast buffet, beverage cart, and a special lunch following the golf tournament. Featured events for the day include Silent and Live auctions, and on course events including a Hole-in-One contest.*

The donation is \$175 per player - \$650 per foursome.
